General Notes:

All activities will be carried out in accordance with "Marvellous History" Health & Safety Policy.

All persons whether members of "Marvellous History" or not are expected to comply with the controls described herein in areas of the event under the control of "Marvellous History".

- In particular, where the control for a Hazard is shown as "Limit Participation", the decision to allow or disallow participation is solely that of the "Marvellous History" representative.
- Failure to comply will result in summary ejection from the event and possible further action.

Definitions for the purposes of this document;

- An "authorised person" is defined as a representative of "Marvellous History".
- A "competent person" is defined as a person who has satisfied a representative of "Marvellous History" that they can safely perform the task identified.
- Prevailing regulations are defined as National Laws & Regulations, Local Laws & Regulations and Event Specific Regulations as appropriate. Where any of these conflict, the most rigorous will take precedent.

A copy of this Risk Assessment will be held electronically by Marvellous History for 5 years from the date of the event to which it pertains.

A copy of this risk assessment will be sent in advance for inspection by the client at the events.

Clients may retain this risk assessment for their records.



How to use this document;

The person filling out this document should complete the information section on Page 1 of this document. Each of the following sections should be reviewed and any deviation from this template noted on the summary form above.

Section 6, Other – Event Specific should have any significant hazards associated with this particular event identified. If there are none, "No Specific Risks" should be written in the Risk column. A copy of the completed risk assessment is to be sent to the society Health & Safety officer by email, or, by post if filled out by hand.

The document is divided into a number of sections, each targeting a particular area. Within each section are a number of columns;
